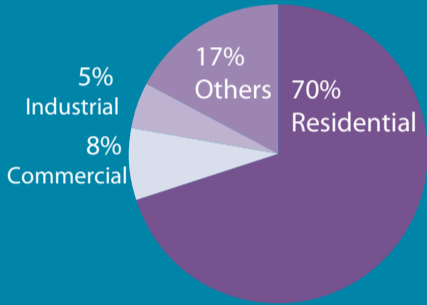

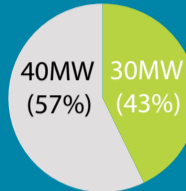

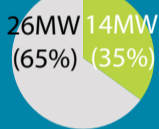
Distribution by Sector



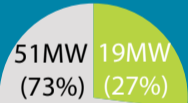
North Gaza (70MW demand)



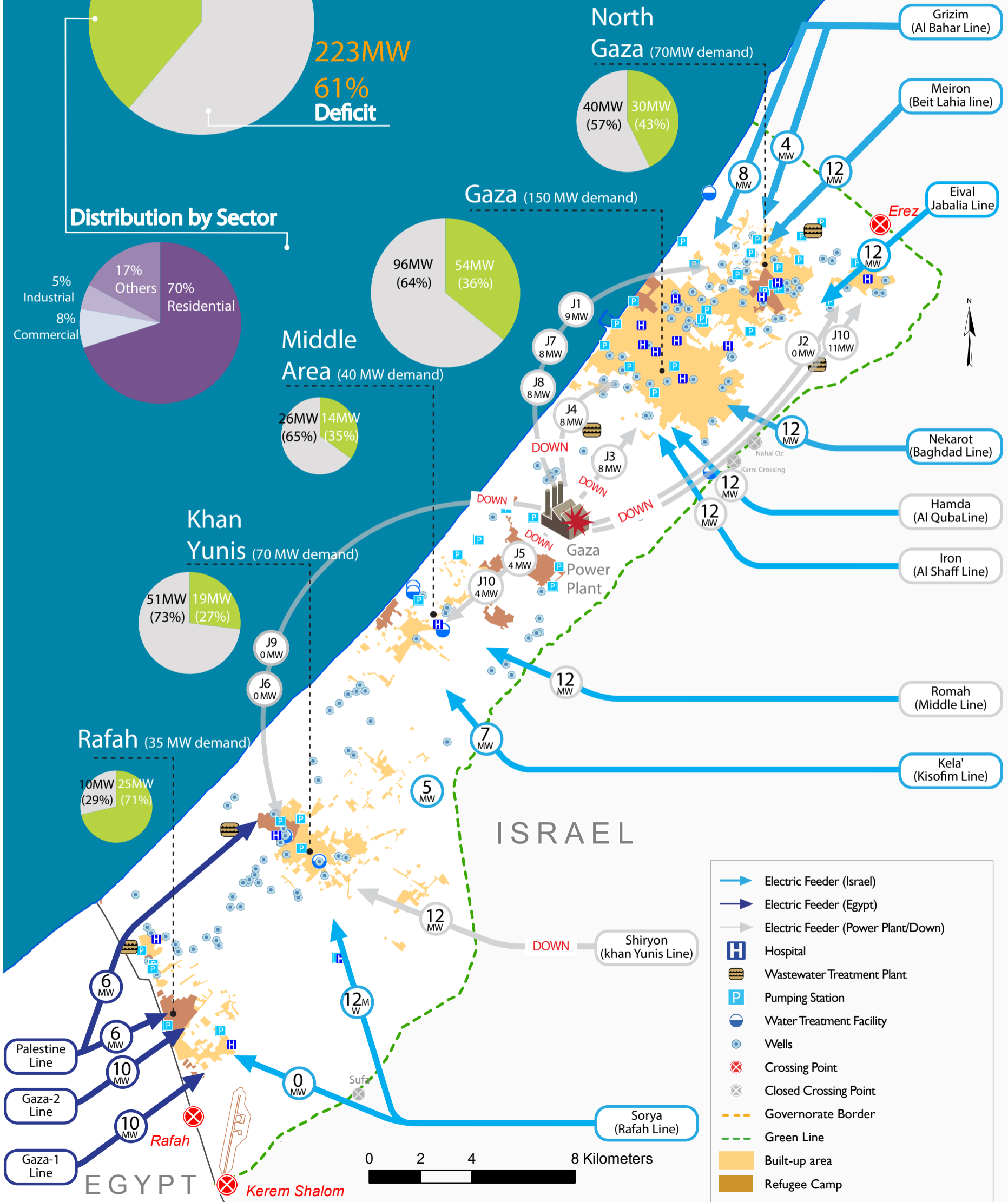
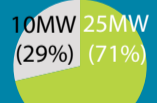
Middle Area (40 MW demand)
