









#### PALESTINIAN CASUALTIES BY WEAPON 1 JANUARY 2024 - 28 FEBRUARY 2025






#### PALESTINIAN CASUALTIES BY GOVERNORATE 1 JANUARY 2024 - 28 FEBRUARY 2025






