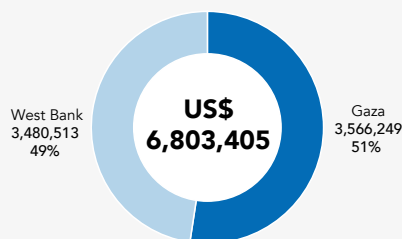


### PROPOSALS RECEIVED & FUNDS DISBURSED

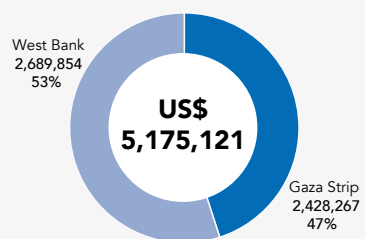
Since the beginning of 2014, ERF in oPt has received 31 project proposals for a total amount of US\$ 7 million (one proposal in April). Of them, 23 projects have been approved to address needs for WASH, Food Security, Education and Emergency Shelter & NFI for total amount US\$ 5.1 million. Of the projects approved, 16 projects are being implemented directly by NNGOs, four projects implemented directly by INGOs, in addition to two projects implemented in partnership between National and International NGOs. One project is being implemented by a UN agency.

\*2 of these proposals were received at the end of 2013 and approved in 2014

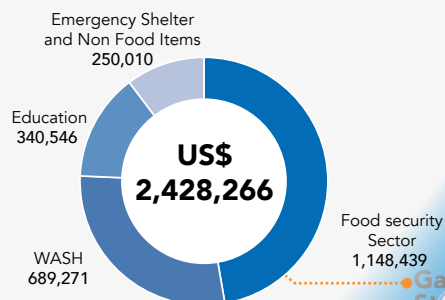
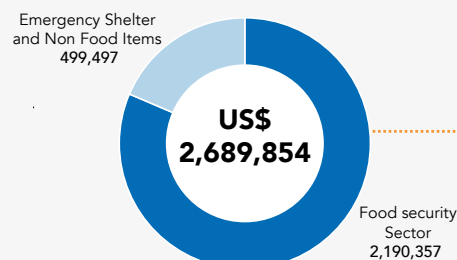
#### RECEIVED PROPOSALS



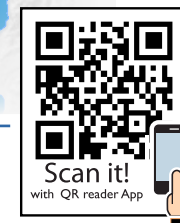
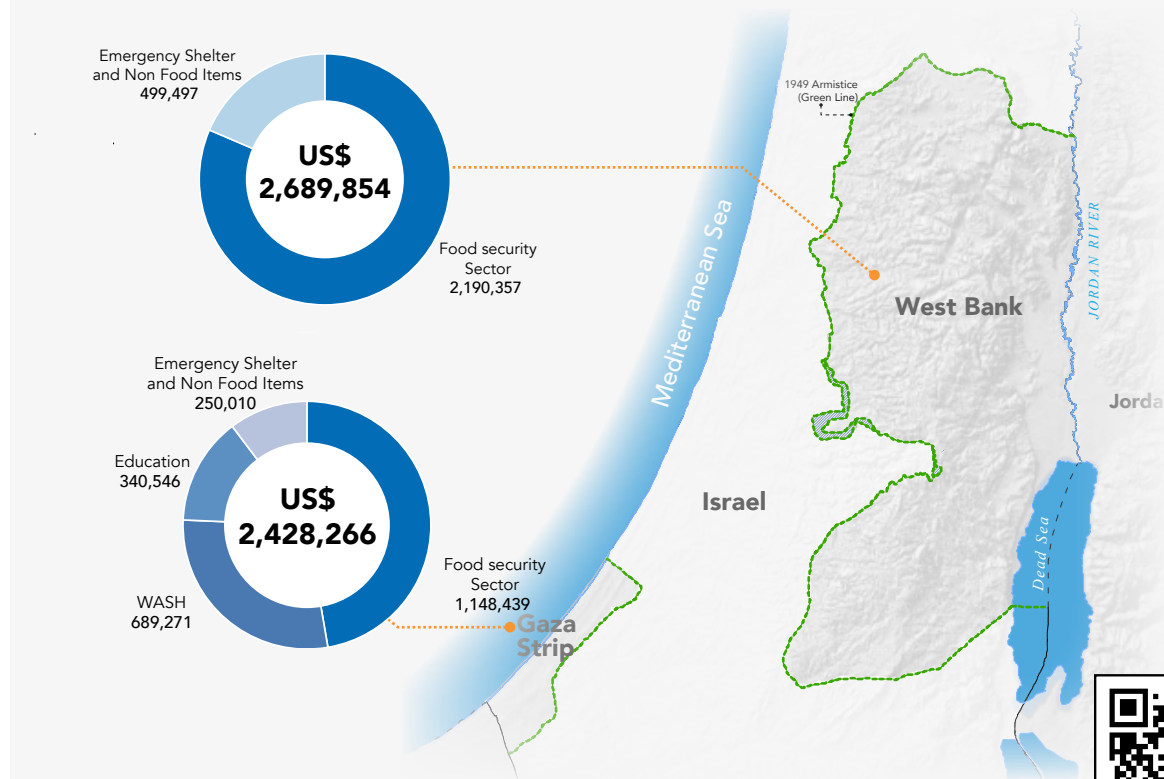
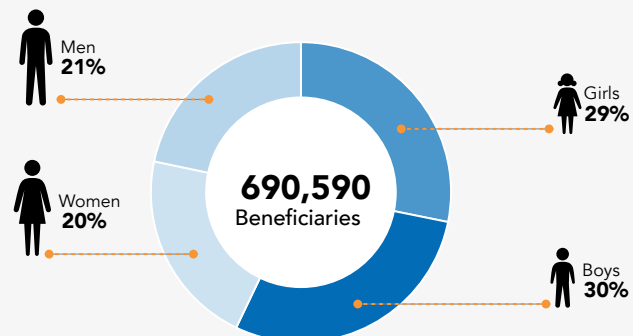
#### APPROVED PROPOSALS



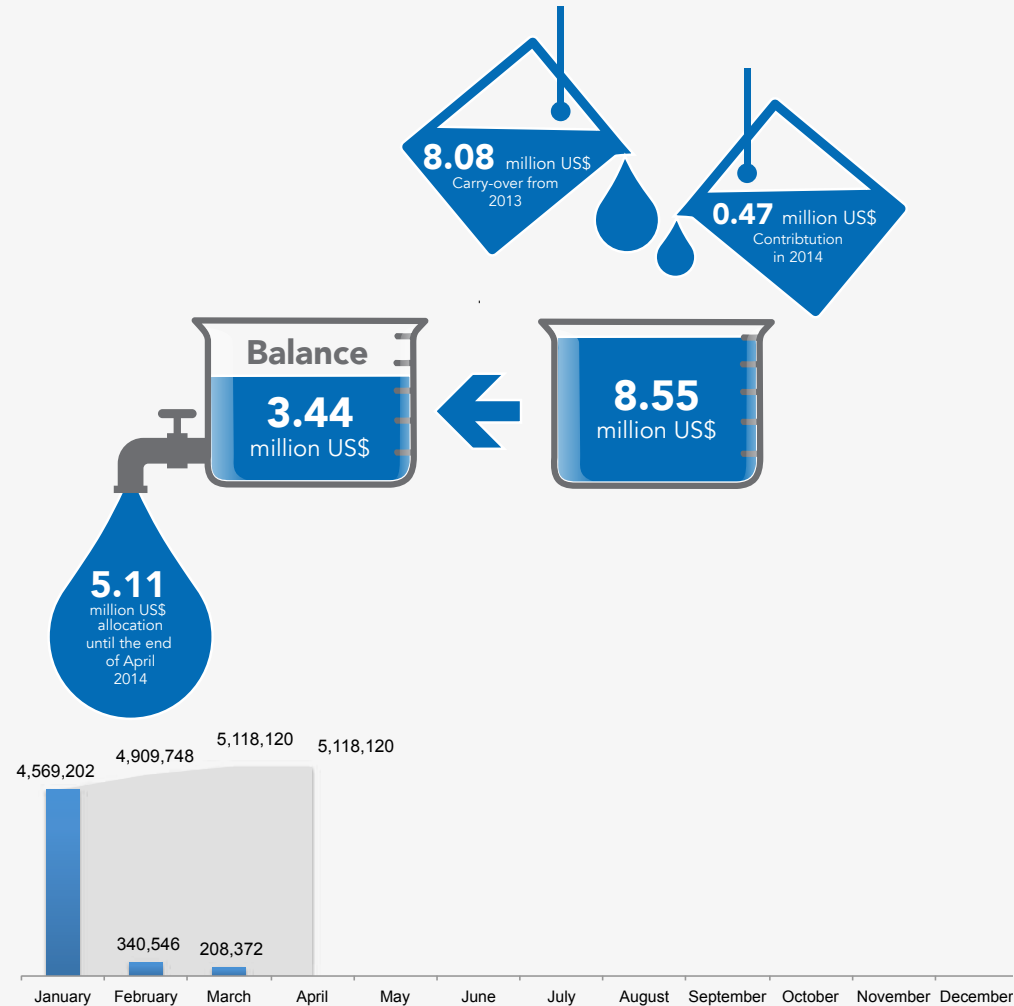
#### FUNDS DISBURSED PER CLUSTER AND LOCATION



#### NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES



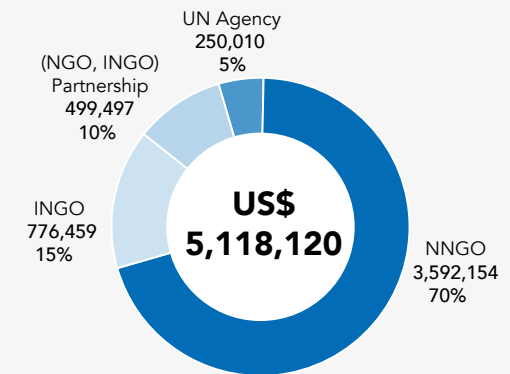

## UPDATE ON DEMOLITIONS OF ERF STRUCTURES

During April 2014, two ERF funded tents were demolished in "Ja'waneh- Khibet tana" area- Nablus. The structures were delivered in May 2012 as a response to a demolition that happened earlier that year. As a result of the demolition in April, 19 persons including two children lost their shelter. The total cost of the tents is 5,819 USD.

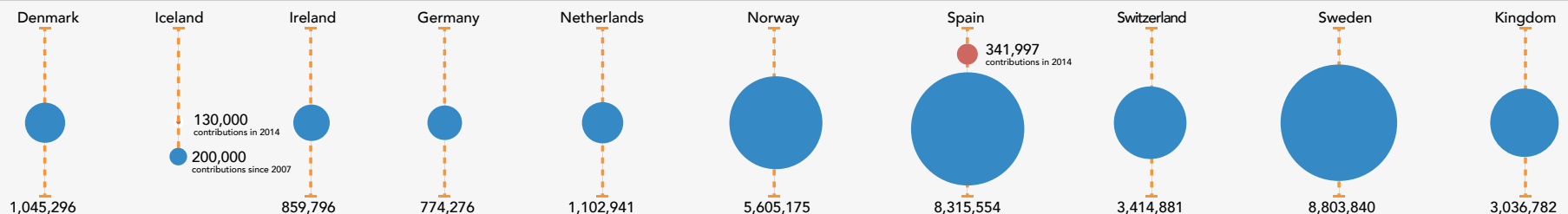
## FUND DISBURSED BY TYPE OF IMPLEMENTING ORGANIZATION
