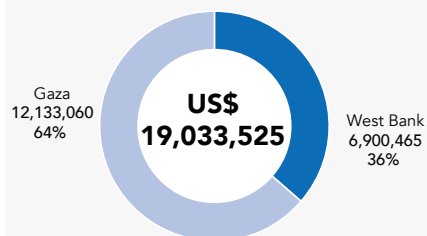


PROPOSALS RECEIVED & FUNDS DISBURSED

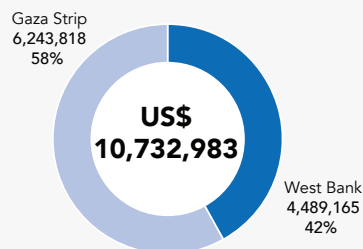
Since the beginning of 2014, ERF in oPt has received 85 project proposals for a total amount of US\$ 19 million. Of them, 48 projects have been approved to address needs for WASH, Food Security, Education, Protection, Health and Emergency Shelter & NFI for a total amount of US\$ 10.7 million. Of the projects approved, 25 projects were implemented directly by NNGOs, 14 projects implemented directly by INGOs, in addition to four projects implemented in partnership between National and International NGOs and five projects implemented by UN agencies.

During the month of August, ERF received 21 proposals to respond to the Gaza emergency, of which 7 proposals have been approved, 8 proposals have been rejected and 6 proposal are still under review.

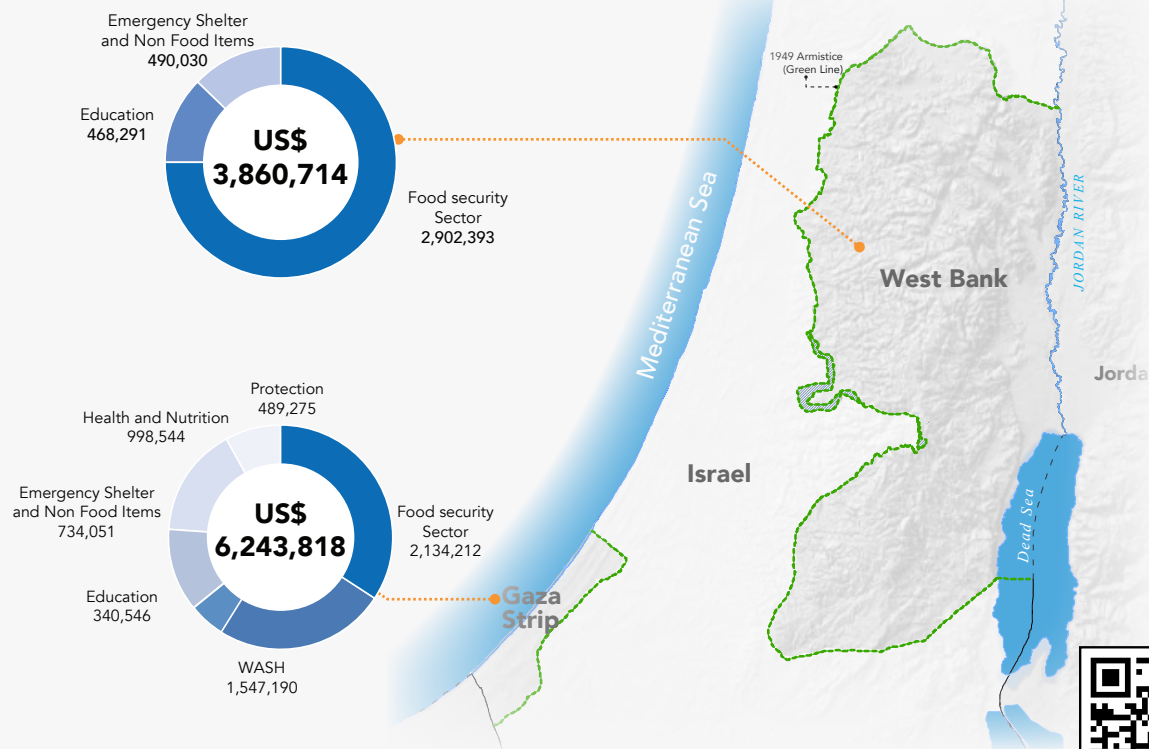
RECEIVED PROPOSALS



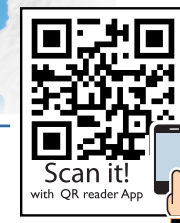
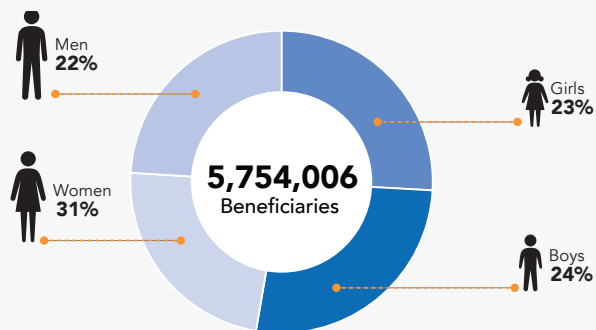
APPROVED PROPOSALS



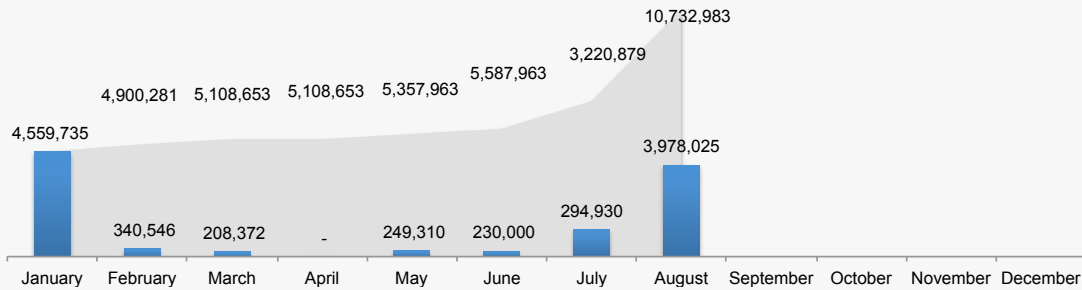
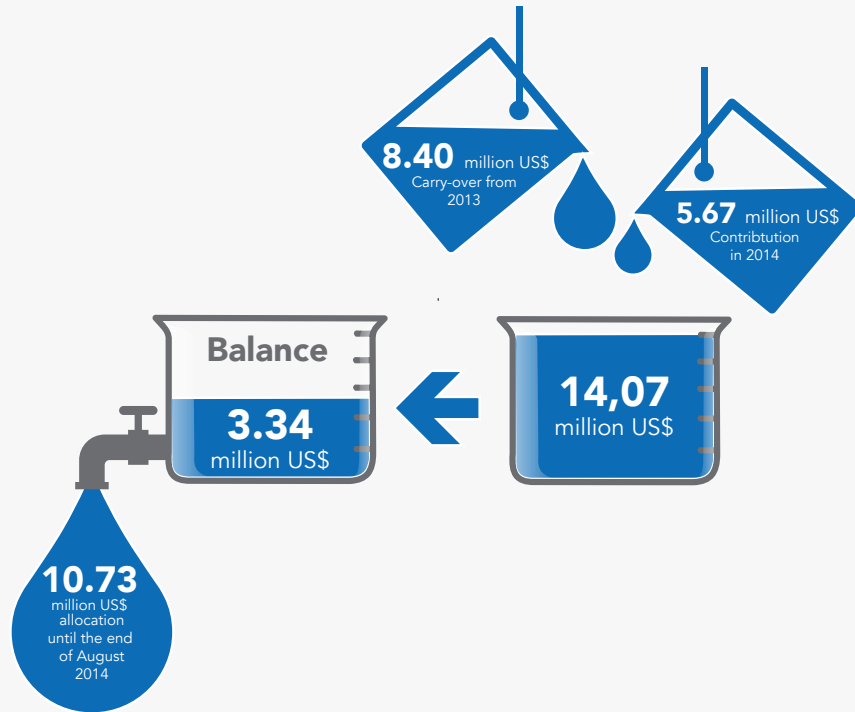
FUNDS DISBURSED PER CLUSTER AND LOCATION



NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES



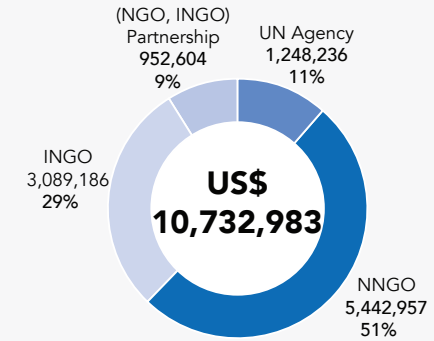
ERF BALANCE AND ALLOCATION

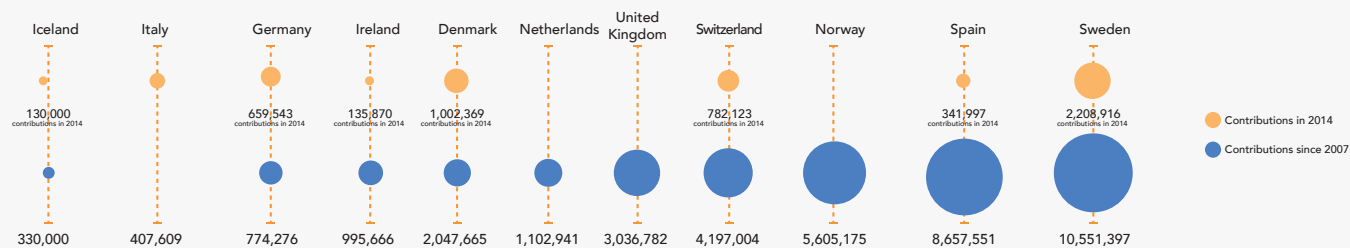
FUNDS DISBURSED BY TYPE OF IMPLEMENTING ORGANIZATION
