

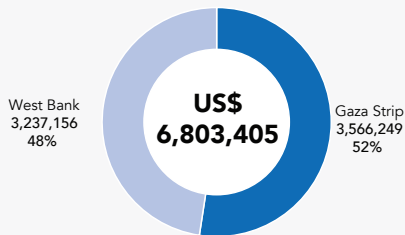
PROPOSALS RECEIVED & FUNDS DISBURSED

Since the beginning of 2014, ERF in oPt has received 30 project proposals in response to humanitarian emergency related to the Winter Storm (Alexa) in December 2013. Of them, 22 projects* have been approved (3 projects in February) to address needs for WASH, Food Security, Education, and Emergency Shelter & NFI for total amount US\$ 4.9 million. Of the projects approved, 15 projects were implemented directly by NNGOs, 4 projects implemented directly by INGOs, in addition to 2 projects implemented in partnership between National and International NGOs and 1 project implemented by UN agency.

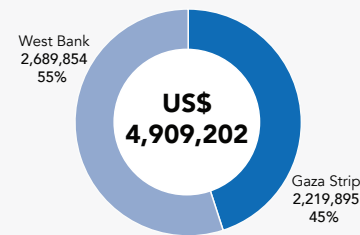

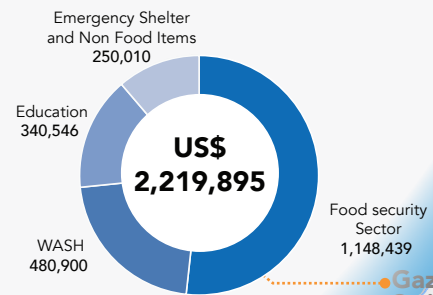
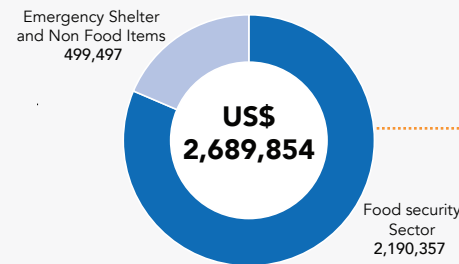
RECEIVED PROPOSALS



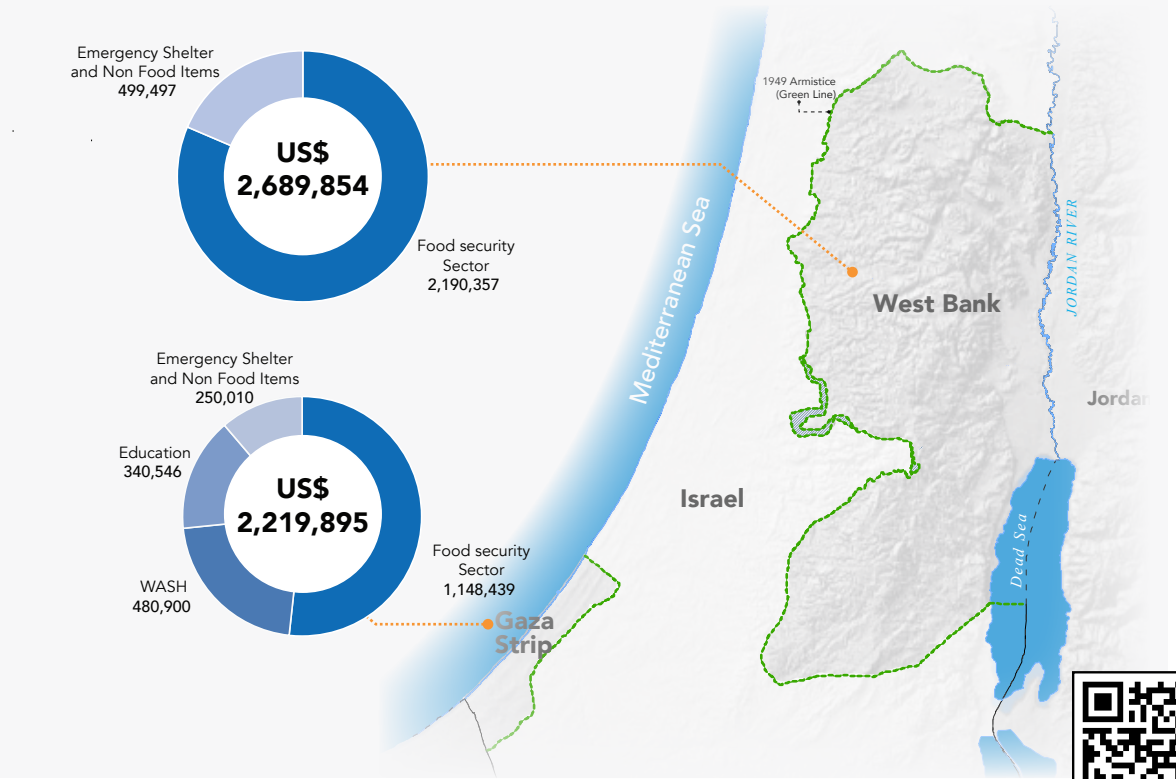
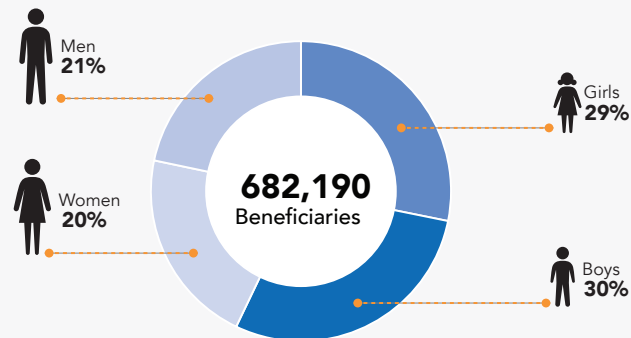
APPROVED PROPOSALS



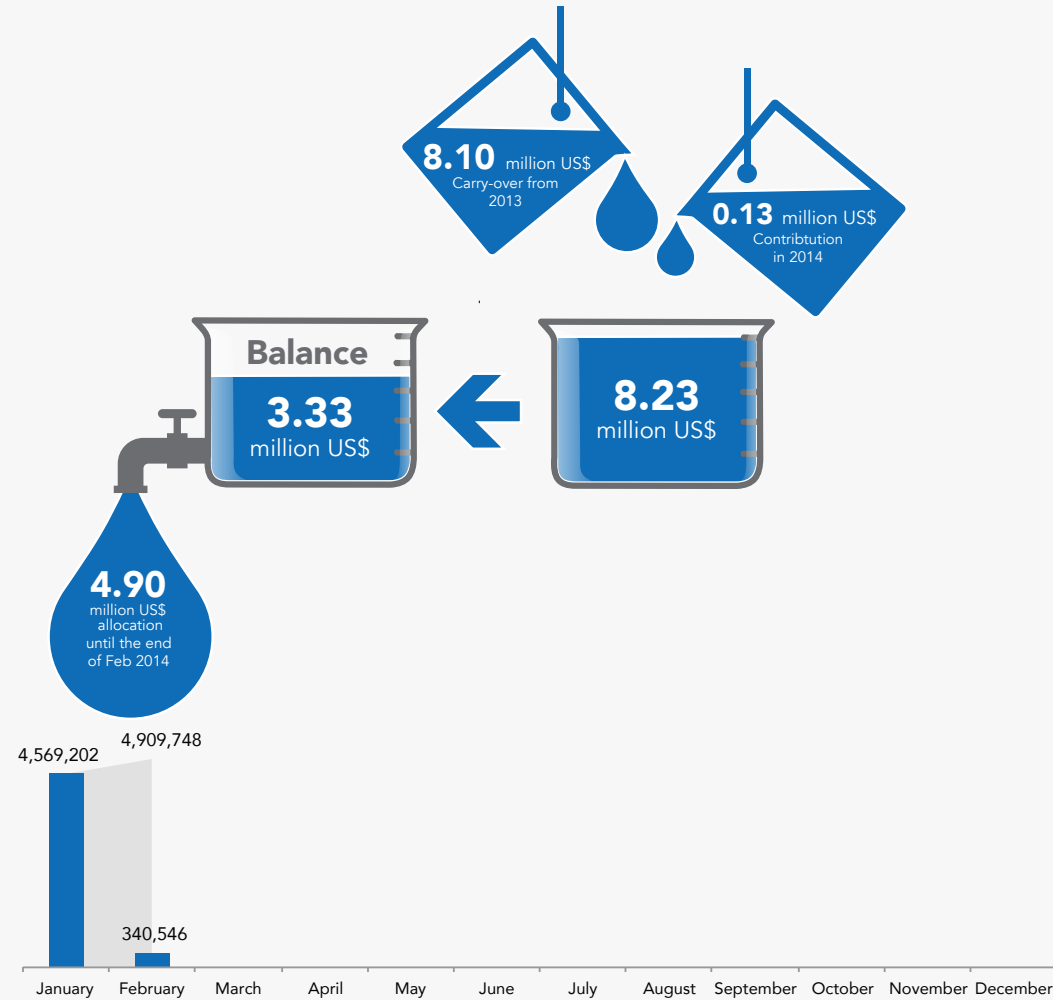
FUNDS DISBURSED PER CLUSTER AND LOCATION

ERF BALANCE AND ALLOCATION

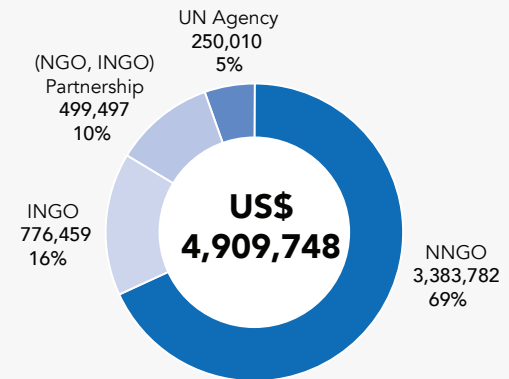


UPDATE ON CONFISCATION OF ERF STRUCTURES

In February 2014, OCHA has recorded one incident that confiscated 3 ERF funded Nylon shades in Khirbet Yarza (Tubas Governorate). As a result, 3 families (19 people were affected).

The total cost of the confiscated items is 1039.5 US\$ (346.5 US\$ each)

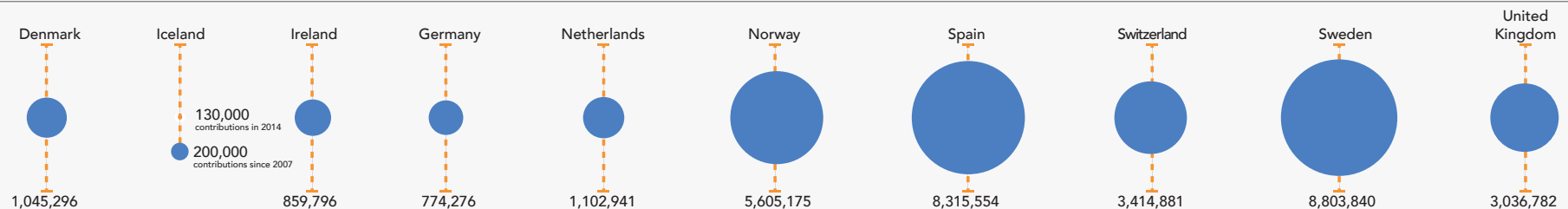
FUND DISBURSED BY TYPE OF IMPLEMENTING ORGANIZATION
