

PROPOSALS RECEIVED & FUNDS DISBURSED

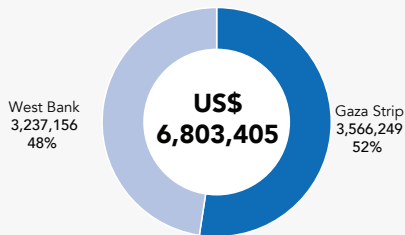
Since the beginning of 2014, ERF in oPt has received 30 project proposals in response to humanitarian emergency related to the Winter Storm (Alexa) in December 2013. Of them, 19 projects* have been approved to address needs for WASH, Food Security sector and Emergency Shelter & NFI for total amount US\$ 4.6 million. Of the projects approved, 13 projects were implemented directly by NNGOs, 3 projects implemented directly by INGOs, in addition to 2 projects implemented in partnership between National and International NGOs and 1 project implemented by UN agency.

*2 proposals were received at the end of 2013 and approved in 2014

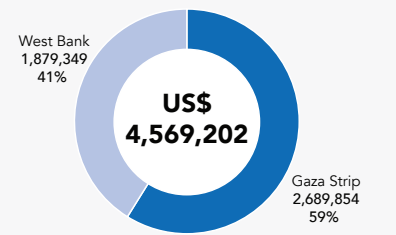


Winter storm in Gaza, December 2013

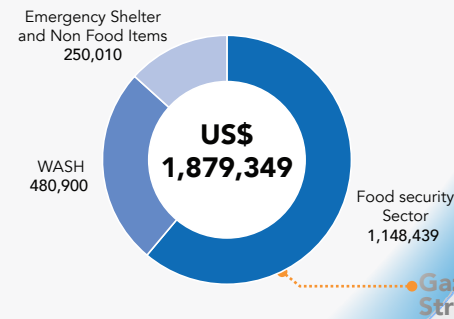
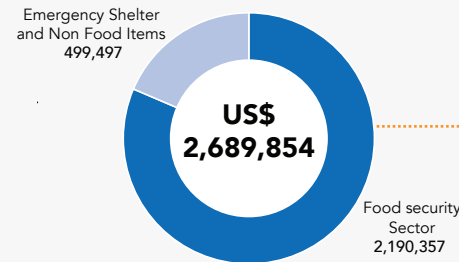

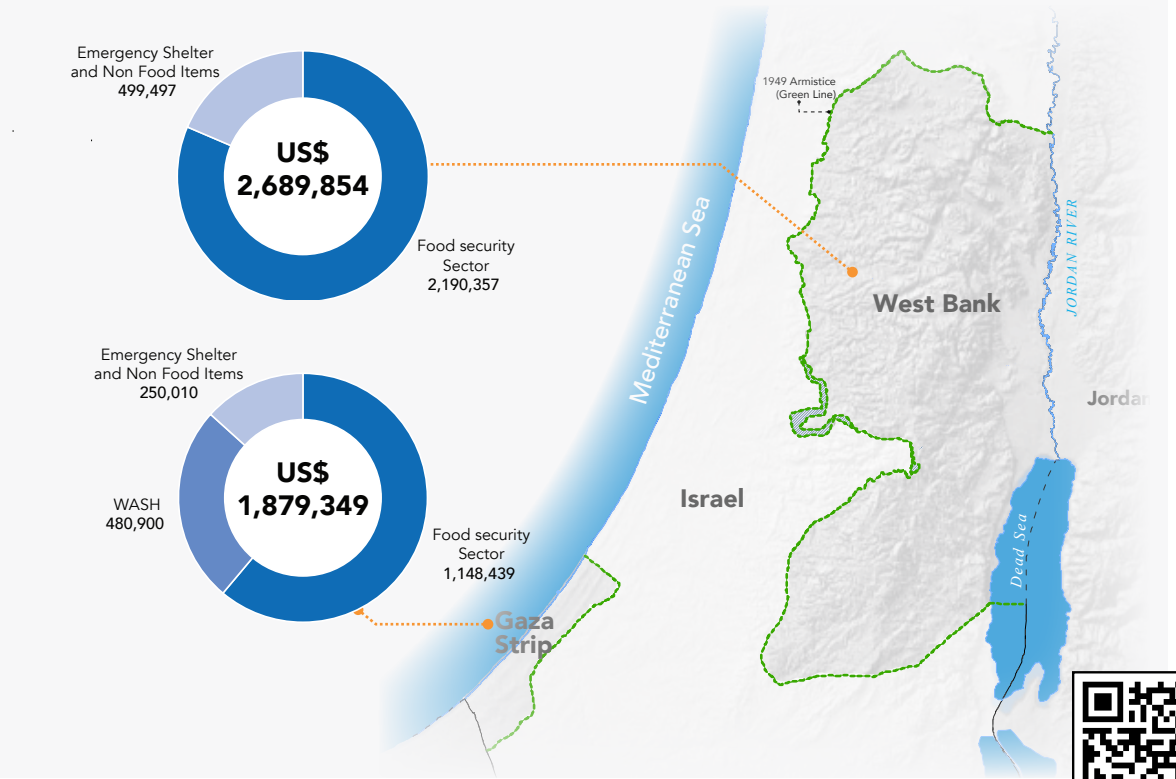
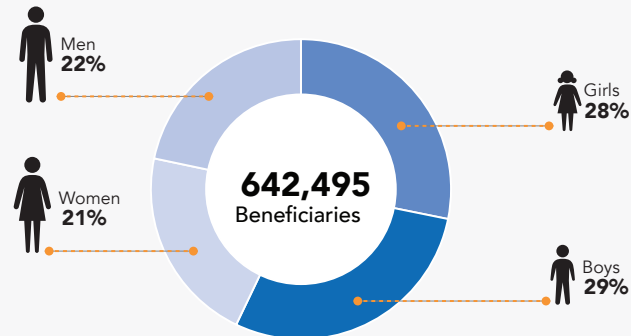
APPROVED PROPOSALS



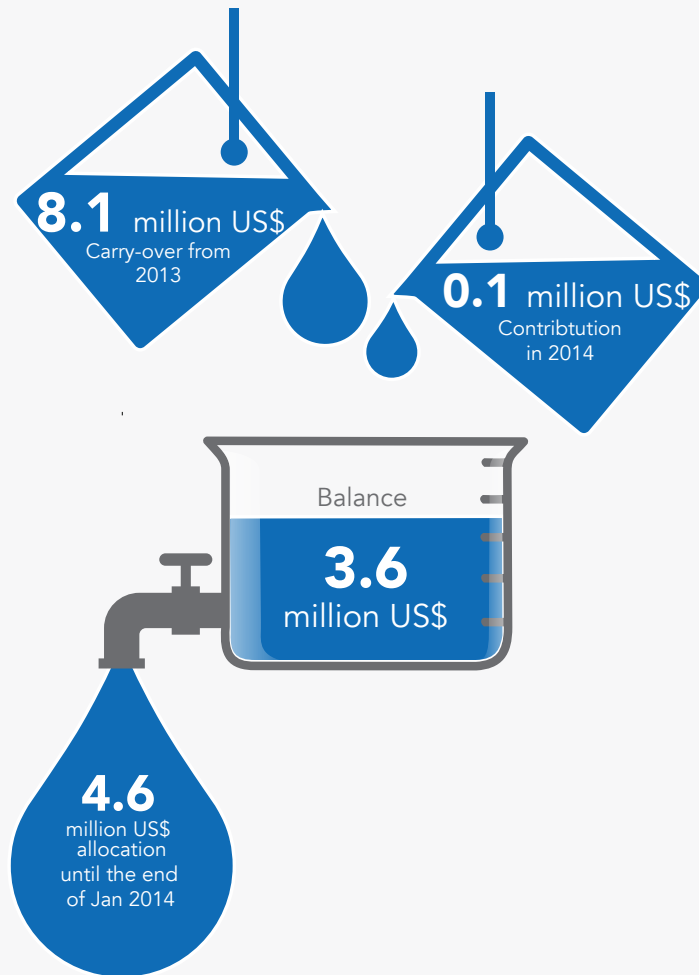
FUNDS DISBURSED PER CLUSTER AND LOCATION



NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES



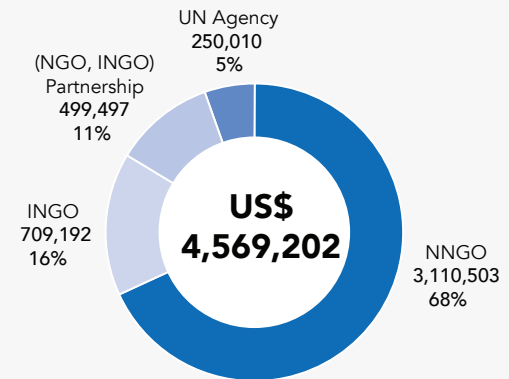
ERF BALANCE AND ALLOCATION



UPDATE ON DEMOLITIONS OF ERF STRUCTURES

In January 2014, OCHA has recorded one demolition incident that targeted 4 ERF funded structures in Khirbet Yarza Bedouin community in Jordan Valley. Overall, 19 structures, including 2 residences, 11 animal shelter, 3 animal pens and 3 mobile latrines, were demolished during the incident. As a result, 14 people (4 children) were displaced and 39 person (19 children) were affected.

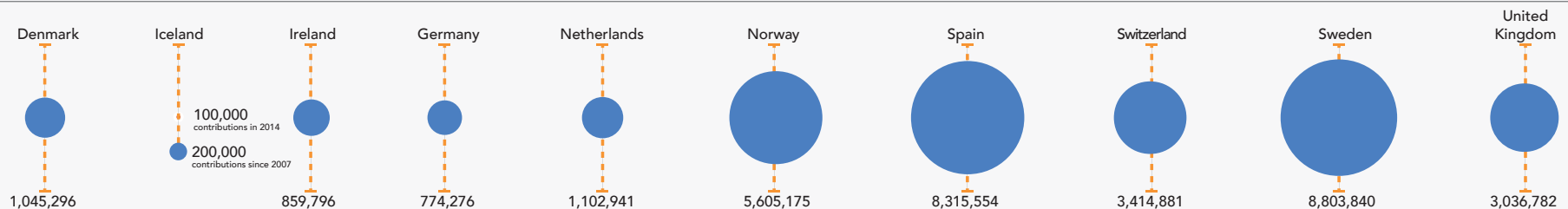
FUND DISBURSED BY TYPE OF IMPLEMENTING ORGANIZATION
