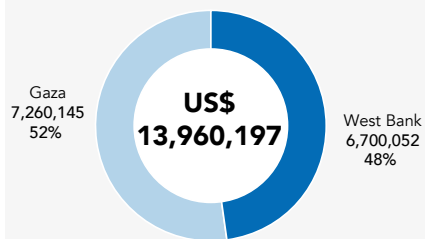


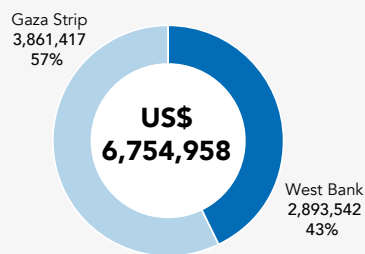
### PROPOSALS RECEIVED & FUNDS DISBURSED

Since the beginning of 2014, ERF in oPt has received 63 project proposals for a total amount of US\$ 14 million. In July, 20 proposals were submitted to cover urgent gaps in Strategic Response Plan "SRP" in addition to 5 proposals to respond to current Gaza crisis and 2 proposals for other needs. Of them, 31 projects have been approved to address needs for WASH, Food Security, Education, Health and Emergency Shelter & NFI for a total amount of US\$ 6.75 million. Of the projects approved, 17 projects were implemented directly by NNGOs, nine projects implemented directly by INGOs, in addition to three projects implemented in partnership between National and International NGOs and two projects implemented by UN agencies.

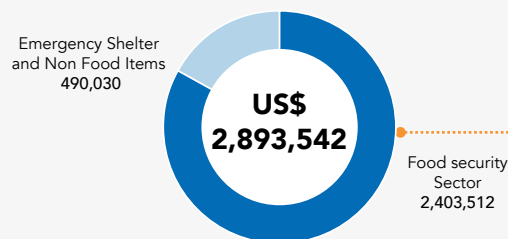
#### RECEIVED PROPOSALS



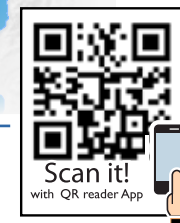
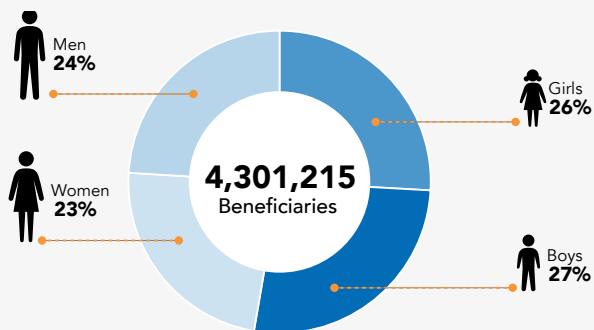
#### APPROVED PROPOSALS



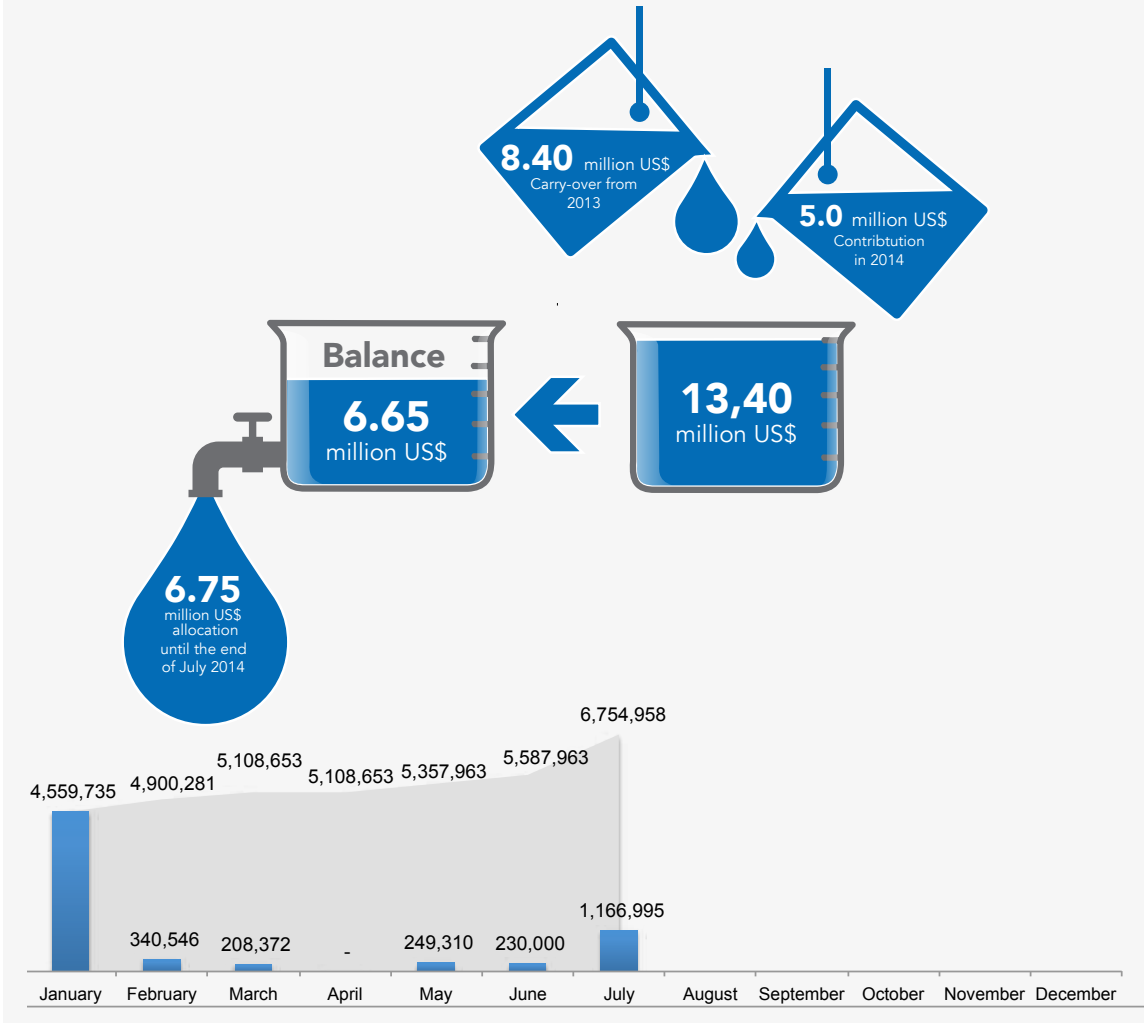
#### FUNDS DISBURSED PER CLUSTER AND LOCATION



#### NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES



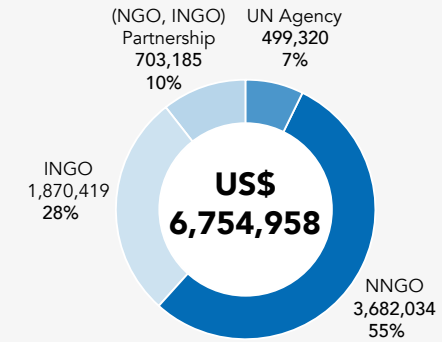

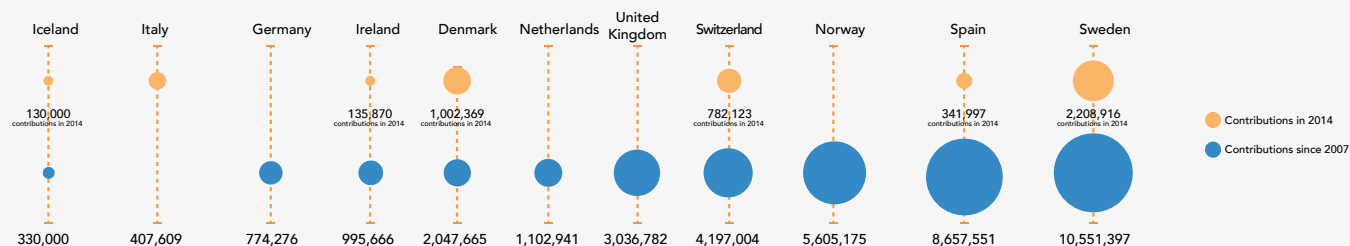
## FUNDS DISBURSED BY TYPE OF IMPLEMENTING ORGANIZATION
