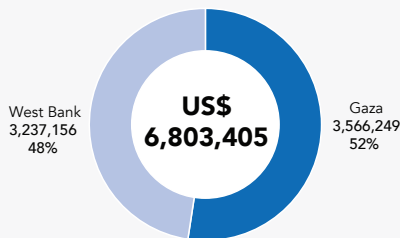


PROPOSALS RECEIVED & FUNDS DISBURSED

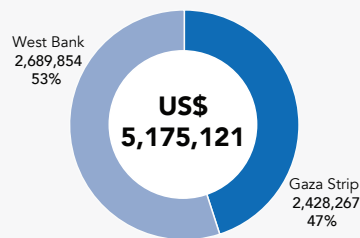
Since the beginning of 2014, ERF in oPt has received 30 project proposals for a total amount of US\$ 6.8 million. Of them, 23 projects have been approved (1 project in March) to address needs for WASH, Food Security, Education and Emergency Shelter & NFI for total amount US\$ 5.1 million. Of the projects approved, 16 projects were implemented directly by NNGOs, four projects implemented directly by INGOs, in addition to two projects implemented in partnership between National and International NGOs and one project implemented by an UN agency.

*2 of these proposals were received at the end of 2013 and approved in 2014

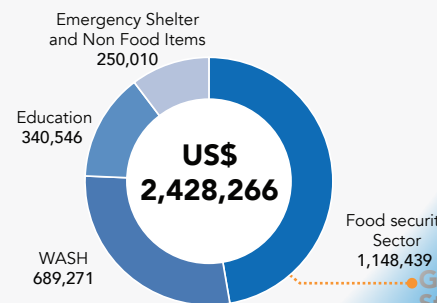
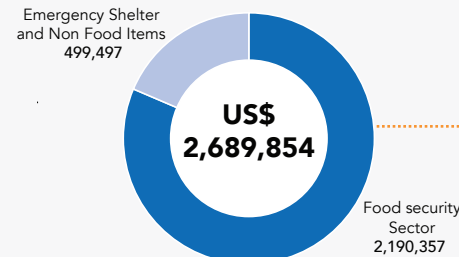
RECEIVED PROPOSALS



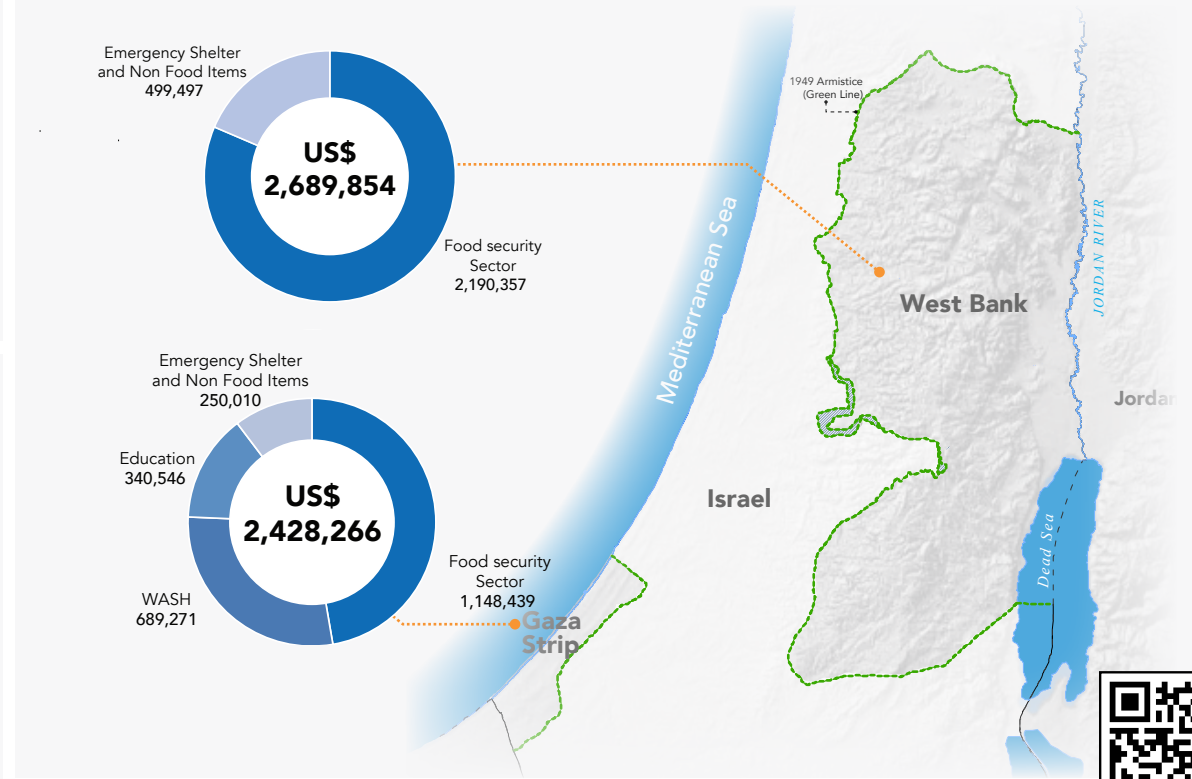
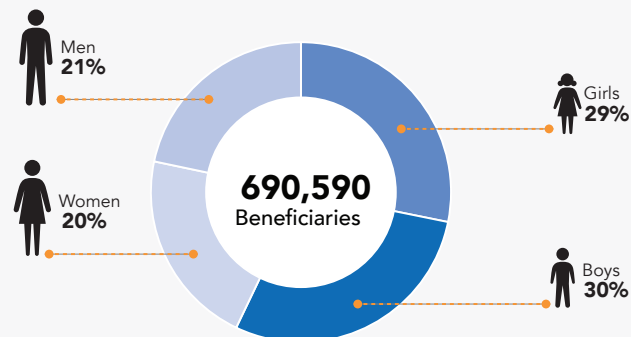
APPROVED PROPOSALS



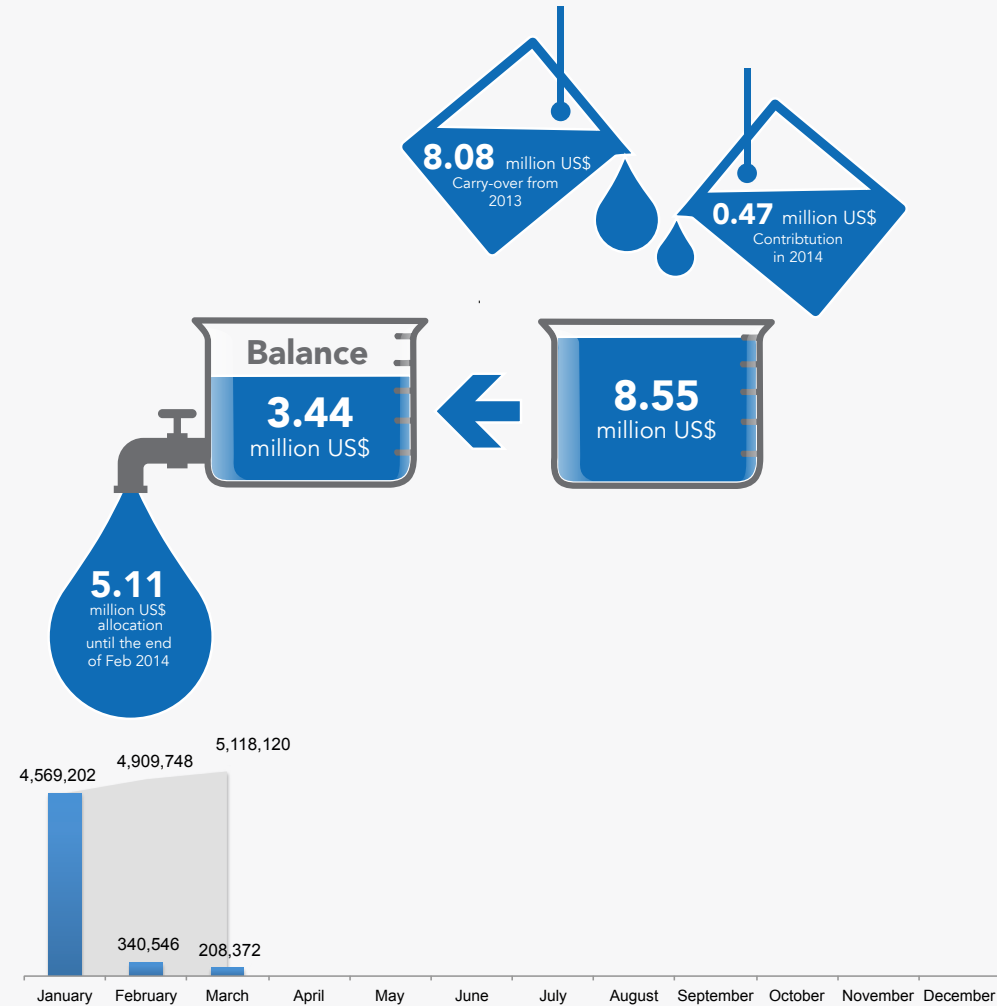
FUNDS DISBURSED PER CLUSTER AND LOCATION



NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES



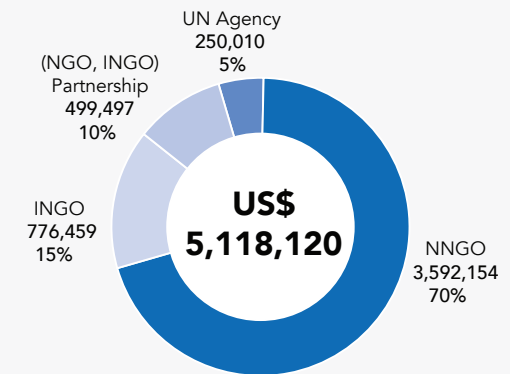
ERF BALANCE AND ALLOCATION



UPDATE ON DEMOLITIONS OF ERF STRUCTURES

During March, one ERF funded portable structure was demolished in East Jerusalem. The structure was delivered in May 2012 as a response to demolition happened earlier that year. In August 2012 a demolition order was issued for the structure, which has been challenged in the court since that date. During March 2014, the owner received a final ultimatum to demolish the structure which forced him to demolish it. As a result four people were displaced. The total cost of the structure in US\$ 17,900.

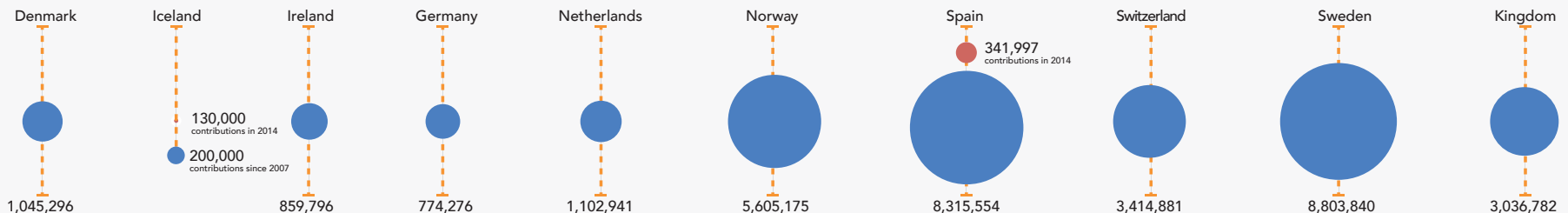
FUND DISBURSED BY TYPE OF IMPLEMENTING ORGANIZATION
