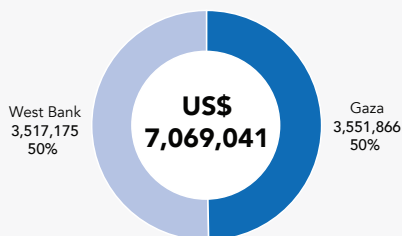


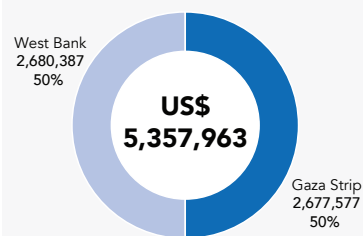
PROPOSALS RECEIVED & FUNDS DISBURSED

Since the beginning of 2014, ERF in oPt has received 33 project proposals (one proposal in May) for a total amount of US\$ 7.3 million. Of them, 24 projects have been approved to address needs for WASH, Food Security, Education, Health and Emergency Shelter & NFI for total amount US\$ 5.35 million. Of the projects approved, 16 projects were implemented directly by NNGOs, four projects implemented directly by INGOs, in addition to two projects implemented in partnership between National and International NGOs and two projects implemented by UN agencies.

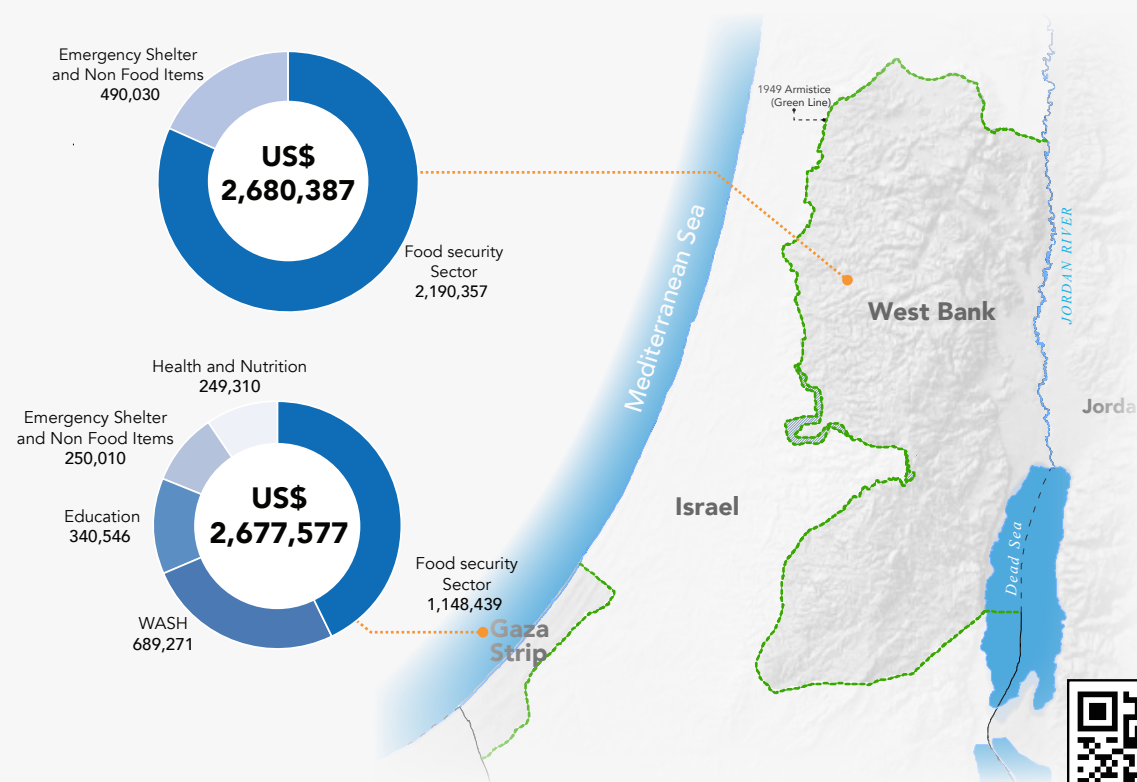
RECEIVED PROPOSALS



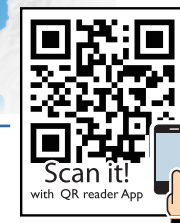
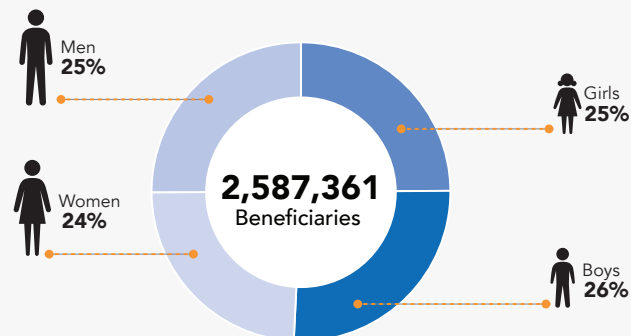
APPROVED PROPOSALS



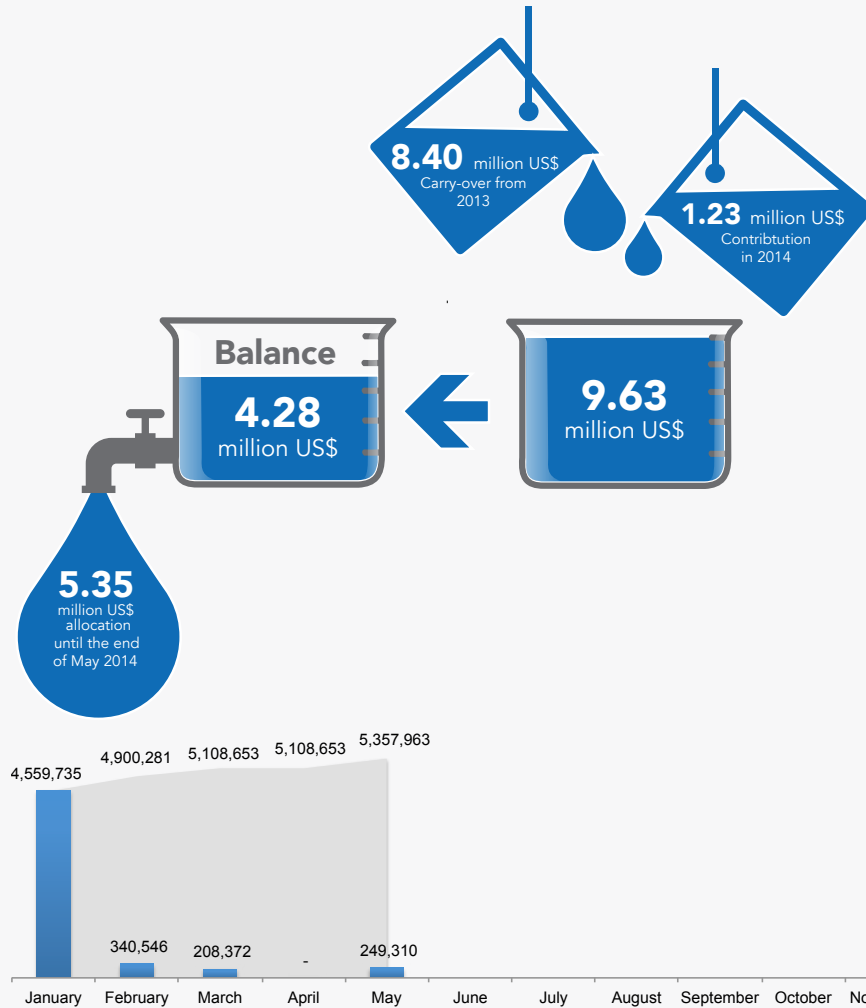
FUNDS DISBURSED PER CLUSTER AND LOCATION



NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES



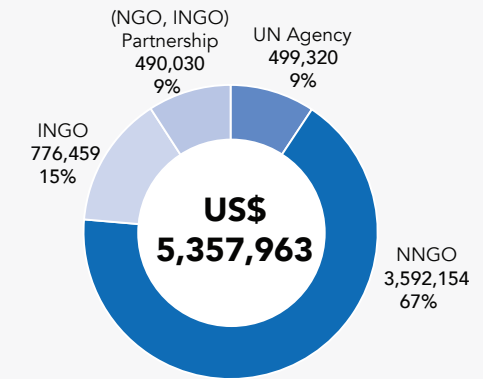

UPDATE ON DEMOLITIONS OF ERF STRUCTURES

During May 2014, a stop work order was issued against an ERF funded structure in Khirbet Ghuwein al Fauqa/ Southern Hebron. The affected residential shelter was provided through ERF in response to damages from the winter storm in December 2013. As a result, one household of eight persons including three women, one boy and four men were put at risk. The cost of the subject humanitarian assistant is 1,380 USD.

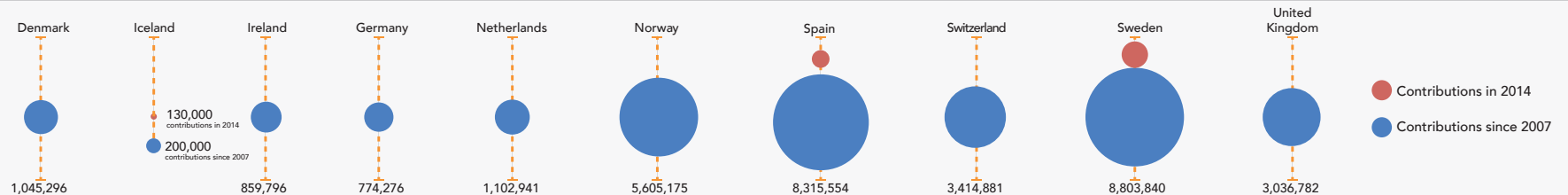
FUND DISBURSED BY TYPE OF IMPLEMENTING ORGANIZATION
