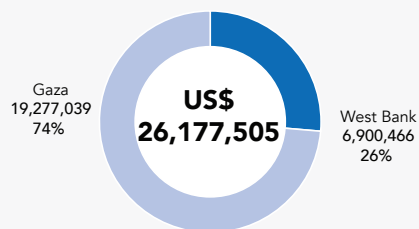


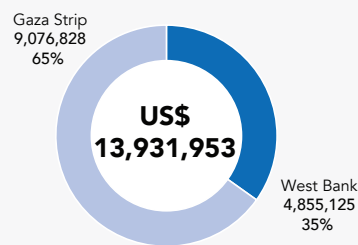
PROPOSALS RECEIVED & FUNDS DISBURSED

Since the beginning of 2014, ERF in oPt has received 119 project proposals for a total amount of US\$ 26 million. Of the total projects received, 64 projects have been approved to address needs for WASH, Food Security, Education, Protection, Health and Emergency Shelter & NFI for a total amount of US\$ 14 million. Of the projects approved, 28 projects were implemented directly by national NGOs, 19 projects implemented directly by international NGOs, in addition to 11 projects implemented in partnership between NNGOs and INGOs and six projects implemented by UN agencies.

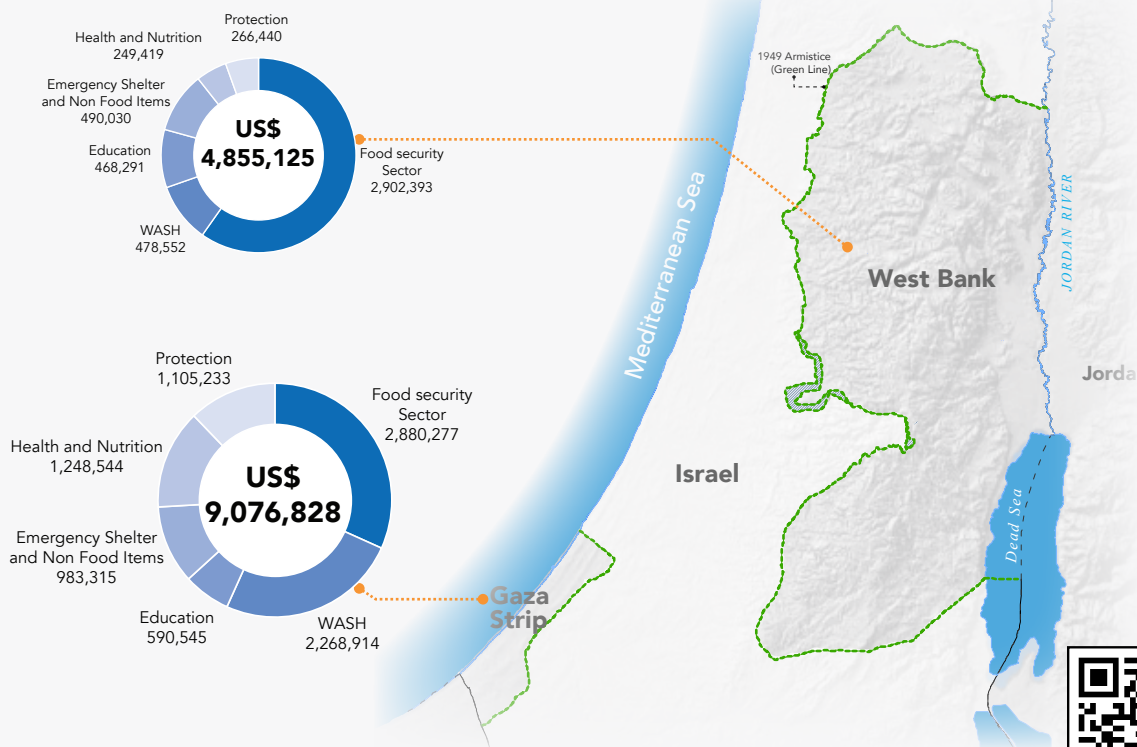
RECEIVED PROPOSALS 2014



APPROVED PROPOSALS 2014



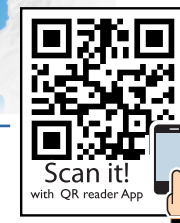
FUNDS DISBURSED PER CLUSTER AND LOCATION



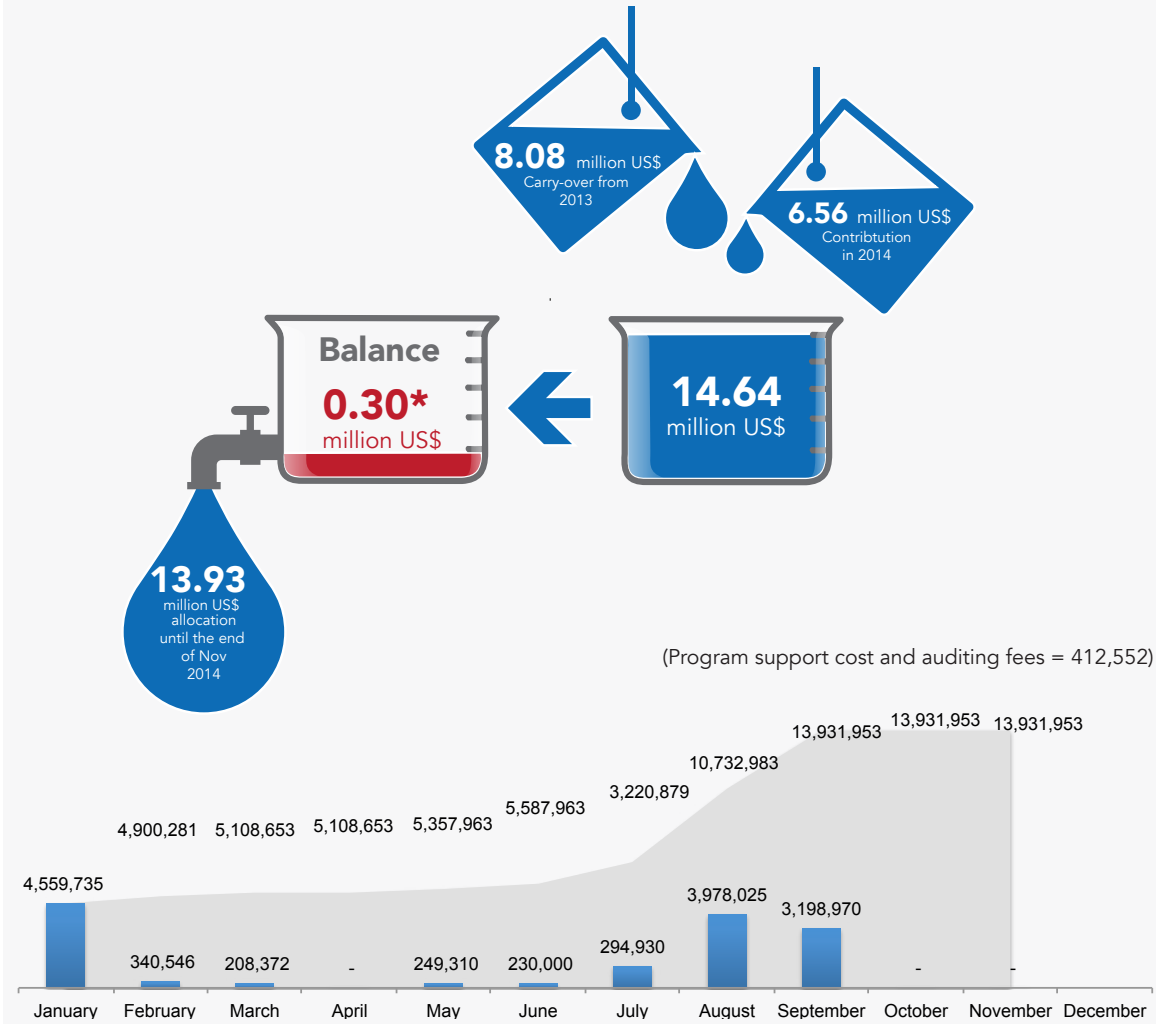

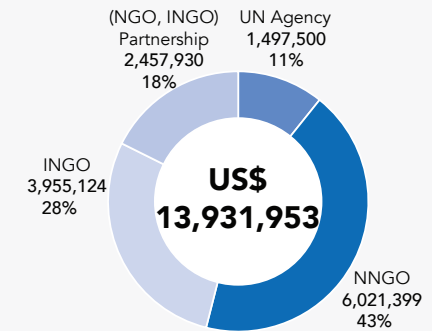

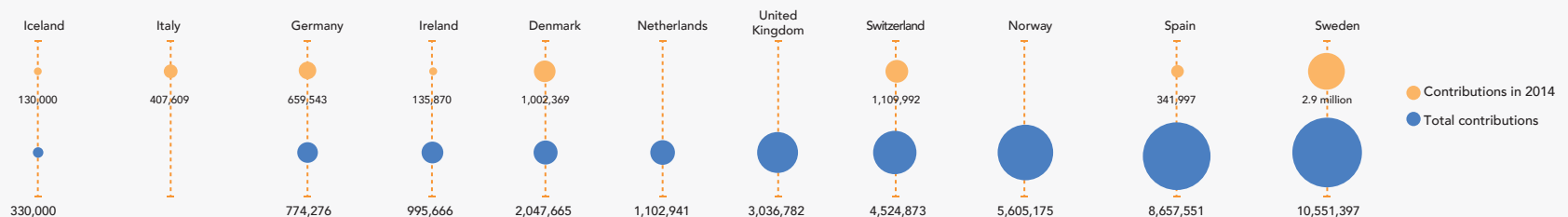
FUNDS DISBURSED BY TYPE OF IMPLEMENTING ORGANIZATION
